How should I use this medicine?

Take this medicine by mouth with food. Follow the directions on the prescription label. Use a specially marked spoon or container to measure your dose. Household spoons are not accurate. Before taking this medicine mix your dose in a glass with 3 to 4 ounces of cold water or juice. Take your medicine at regular intervals. Do not take your medicine more often than directed. Do not stop taking except on your doctor's advice.\n \nTalk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. Special care may be needed.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once.\nNOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

Where should I keep my medicine?

Keep out of the reach of children.\n\nStore at room temperature between 15 and 30 degrees C (59 and 86 degrees F). Protect from light and moisture. Throw away any unused medicine after the expiration date.

What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible\n\n -allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue\n -black, tarry stools\n -breathing problems\n -confusion\n -fast, irregular heartbeat\n -feeling faint or lightheaded, falls\n -low blood pressure\n -numbness or tingling in hands or feet\n -unusually weak or tired\n -weakness, heaviness of legs\n \n\Side effects the usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome):\n\n -diarrhea\n -nausea, vomiting\n
