How should I use this medicine?

This medicine is for external use only. Do not take by mouth. Follow the directions on the prescription label. Make sure the skin is clean and dry. Apply just enough foam to cover the affected areas. Rub in gently. Wash your hands after applying the foam. Use your medicine at regular intervals. Do not use it more often than directed.\(^1\) \(\text{nTalk}\) to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. While this drug may be prescribed for children as young as 12 years for selected conditions, precautions do apply.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once.\nNOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

Where should I keep my medicine?

Keep out of the reach of children.\n\nStore at room temperature between 15 and 30 degrees C (59 and 86 degrees F). Do not freeze. Throw away any unused medicine after the expiration date.\n\nThis medicine is flammable. Avoid exposure to heat, fire, flame, and smoking.

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible:\n\n -allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue\n -changes in skin color\n -pain or tenderness of the skin\n -severe burning, dryness, itching, reddening, crusting, or swelling of the treated areas\n \n\side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome):\n\n -dry skin\n -increased sensitivity to the sun\n -mild burning or stinging after applying\n -red, inflamed, and irritated skin, the skin may peel after a few days
