**How should I use this medicine?**

Take this medicine by mouth with a glass of water. Follow the directions on the prescription label. You can take this medicine with or without food. Take your doses at regular intervals. Do not take your medicine more often than directed. Do not stop taking except on the advice of your doctor or health care professional. A special MedGuide will be given to you by the pharmacist with each prescription and refill. Be sure to read this information carefully each time. Talk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. While this drug may be prescribed for children as young as 6 years of age for selected conditions, precautions do apply.

**Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once. NOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.**

**Where should I keep my medicine?**

Keep out of the reach of children. Store at room temperature between 15 and 30 degrees C (59 and 86 degrees F). Throw away any unused medicine after the expiration date.

**What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?**

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible: allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue; breathing problems; confusion; feeling faint or lightheaded, falls; fever or chills, sore throat; increased hunger or thirst; increased urination; joint pain; muscle pain, spasms; problems with balance, talking, walking; restlessness or need to keep moving; seizures; suicidal thoughts or other mood changes; trouble swallowing; uncontrollable and excessive urges (examples: gambling, binge eating, shopping, having sex); uncontrollable head, mouth, neck, arm, or leg movements; unusually weak or tired. Side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome): blurred vision; constipation; headache; nausea, vomiting; trouble sleeping; weight gain.
