How should I use this medicine?

Take this medicine by mouth with a glass of water. Follow the directions on the prescription label. You can take this medicine with or without food. Take your medicine at regular intervals and at the same time each day. Do not take it more often than directed. Do not stop taking except on your doctor's advice.
Talk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. Special care may be needed.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once.
NOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

Where should I keep my medicine?

Keep out of the reach of children.
Store at room temperature between 20 and 25 degrees C (68 and 77 degrees F). Throw away any unused medicine after the expiration date.

What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible:
-allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue
-changes in vision
-falls
-hallucination, loss of contact with reality
-high blood pressure
-signs and symptoms of hypertensive crisis like severe headache with confusion and blurred vision, severe chest pain, shortness of breath, nausea and vomiting, seizures
-signs and symptoms of low blood pressure like dizziness; feeling faint or lightheaded, falls; unusually weak or tired
-signs and symptoms of serotonin syndrome like confusion, heavy sweating, fever, involuntary muscle jerking, tremor, rigid muscles, unstable blood pressure, diarrhea
-suddenly falling asleep or sudden feelings of wanting to fall asleep during usual activities like driving or eating
-uncontrolled, sudden body movements (dyskinesia)
-unusual or obvious changes in behavior such as agitation, confusion, disorganized thinking
Side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report these to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome):
-nausea
-trouble sleeping
-upset stomach
