How should I use this medicine?

Take this medicine by mouth with a glass of water. Follow the directions on the prescription label. You can take it with or without food. If it upsets your stomach, take it with food. Take your medicine at regular intervals. Do not take it more often than directed. In \nA special MedGuide will be given to you by the pharmacist with each prescription and refill. Be sure to read this information carefully each time. In \nTalk to your pediatrician regarding the use of this medicine in children. This medicine is not approved for use in children.

Overdosage: If you think you have taken too much of this medicine contact a poison control center or emergency room at once.\nNOTE: This medicine is only for you. Do not share this medicine with others.

Where should I keep my medicine?

Keep out of the reach of children. This drug can be abused. Keep this medicine in a safe place to protect it from theft. Do not share this medicine with anyone. Selling or giving away this medicine is dangerous and is against the law.\n\nThis medicine may cause accidental overdose and death if taken by other adults, children, or pets. Mix any unused medicine with a substance like cat littler or coffee grounds. Then throw the medicine away in a sealed container like a sealed bag or a coffee can with a lid. Do not use the medicine after the expiration date.\n\nStore at room temperature between 15 and 30 degrees C (59 and 86 degrees F). Keep the container tightly closed.

What side effects may I notice from receiving this medicine?

Side effects that you should report to your doctor or health care professional as soon as possible:\n\n -allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue\n -breathing problems\n -confusion\n -signs and symptoms of a dangerous change in heartbeat or heart rhythm like chest pain; dizziness; fast or irregular heartbeat; palpitations; feeling faint or lightheaded, falls; breathing problems\n -signs and symptoms of low blood pressure like dizziness; feeling faint or lightheaded, falls; unusually weak or tired\n -signs and symptoms of a stroke like changes in vision; confusion; trouble speaking or understanding; severe headaches; sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg; trouble walking; dizziness; loss of balance or coordination\n -trouble passing urine or change in the amount of urine\n \n\Side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor or health care professional if they continue or are bothersome):\n\n -anxious\n -constipation\n -nausea, vomiting\n -tiredness\n -trouble sleeping
